recognition

God calls out and judges our sin, we agree, believe, and turn to Him for salvation.

Celebrant: Hear the words of God: "If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us; but if we confess our sins, God is faithful and just to forgive our sins, and cleanse us from all unrighteousness."
1 John 1:8 - 9

Celebrant and People: Most merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we earnestly repent. For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may delight in your will, and walk in your ways, to the glory of your Name. Amen.

Celebrant: Confess your sins to God and receive his grace in this meal. Arise and take communion, remembering that Christ's body was broken and his blood spilled for the remission of your sins.

COMMUNION
GOSPEL PROCLAMATION

Celebrant: Please stand.

Celebrant: Hear these words, oh children of the Most High God: Jesus Christ, the son of God, suffered under the hands of men, by the will of God, for the reconciliation of your souls and daily living. Jesus Christ died and was buried, and on the third day rose from the dead. Beloved children of God, hear and receive: your sins have been forgiven! You have called and the Lord has answered! He has freed you from the yoke of sin and unrighteousness and the burden of self-condemnation. You are now reconciled to God and free to live lives of thriving, with abundant joy, by the power of the Holy Spirit.

People: Praise be to God for he has rescued us from death and made us alive in Christ!
